Kelly provides education and outreach on the NYS stormwater regulations and erosion and sediment control to contractors, developers, engineers and municipal staff in Monroe County. She conducts stormwater construction inspections and stormwater pollution prevention plan reviews. Kelly has over 20 years of experience with Soil and Water Conservation Districts including a Conservation District Technician position with Cayuga County SWCD for over 4 years. She has worked with many local landowners and residential homeowners on identifying water quality issues and planning and implementing solutions to the problems.
